LOCATION

Lessons will be conducted at NUS Main Campus, Singapore.

CAMP FEES

The cost of the NUS Computing Camp fees is S\$1360.00 per student. It is inclusive of seminars, activities, field trips, accommodation and meals during the programme. It does NOT cover airfare, travel insurance and personal expenses. The cost is also inclusive of the prevailing Goods and Service Tax (GST).



REGISTRATION

To register for the Computing Camp, please get the participants to complete the Registration Form attached and send it back to NUS for processing (*e-submission of the registration forms is acceptable*).

Please note that registration will be confirmed only after the receipt of the payment.

- **The application closing dates for Computing Camp intake will be 4th November 2010.**
- **A place will be reserved upon the receipt of completed application form.** The applicant will have the window period of **10 days** after the submission of application to make the payment. Thus, the **payment should be made by 15th Nov 2010.** The registration will be considered successful **ONLY upon receipt of full payment** of prevailing intake program fees. A letter of confirmation will be sent to all successful applicants via email.
- Registration is on a **first-come, first-served basis.** After reaching the maximum number of applicants for the program, rest of the applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
